UVALDE MEMORIAL HOSPITAL (UMH) in Uvalde, TX is seeking a RHC Administrator to serve their facility. UMH is looking for a professional to be responsible for their RHC. The candidate should have well-developed leadership and management abilities, including developing and managing a budget, as well as a working knowledge of Medicare RHC Conditions of Participation. This individual should possess exceptional communication and interpersonal skills and be able to successfully relate to, manage and supervise employees. The selected individual will demonstrate a commitment to providing a superior patient experience. Additional consideration given to candidates that are a Certified Rural Health Clinic Professional (CRHCP).

UMH Rural Health Clinic (RHC) which accommodates healthcare providers under the umbrella of UMH which increases the community's access to quality primary healthcare at a price the community can afford by streamlining costs and providing community health. The Clinic Administrator will report to and work closely with the CEO, with responsibility of overseeing the day-to-day operations and developing new business relations while maintaining existing ones.

Master's degree preferred and BLS/CPR Certification required within 6 months of hire. Three (3) years of healthcare administration experience, including one (1) year of supervisory experience in a healthcare setting. Rural healthcare experience strongly preferred. Five (5) or more years of directly related work experience in a rural clinic setting may be substituted in lieu of a Bachelor's, or more than six (6) years of comparable experience in healthcare.

Uvalde Memorial Hospital is a Critical Access Hospital (CAH), 501(c)(3) not-for-profit county hospital serving the residents of Uvalde, Zavala, Kinney, Real, and Edwards counties with a population draw of over 45,000 residents. The hospital is governed by a seven (7) member board of directors. The ER is a certified LEVEL IV Trauma Center providing Emergency Services 24 hours a day seven days a week. The hospital has Cardiac/Pulmonary Care, Endoscopy Lab, Hematology and Oncology, Hospice, ICU, Laboratory, Med/Surg Care, Obstetrics, Women' & Newborns, Pharmacy, Physical Therapy, Radiology/Imaging, Speech Therapy, Inpatient/Outpatient Surgery, Orthopedic, Wound Care, Outpatient Specialty Clinic and Crossroads Behavioral Health Program for Seniors. UMH is accredited by The Joint Commission and Modern Healthcare "Best Places to Work 2022".

Uvalde has over 15,000 population and is situated at the southwest corner of the Hill Country. It is located at the crossroads of the nation's two longest highways: U.S Hwy 90 and U.S. Hwy 83. Uvalde is 84 miles west of San Antonio and 160 miles southwest of Austin, Texas.
